Have extra cash on-hand for emergencies (at least \$10.00 per week).

Unplug electrical items to protect from power surges.

Bring in all exterior items.

Have a supply of medical needs including all prescription drugs.

Call 911 in an emergency.

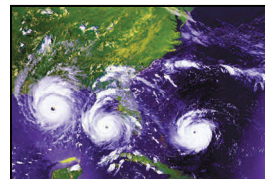
Do Not:

Do not put tape on windows or board up windows.

Do not leave electrical appliances plugged in.

Do not leave doors and windows open and/or unlocked.

Do not leave unit at any time during the storm.

Ventilating Your Units

Summer time is here and BCHA would like to remind you to ventilate your units.

Summer heat and humidity may cause mold to occur in your unit. Here are some tips on how to prevent mold:

- Use cooking vents when cooking.
- Use ceiling fans.
- Leave bathroom and shower doors open after use.
- Wipe down any vanity/sink tops.

- Avoid air drying dishes.
- Wipe down any and all visible moisture.
- Keep A/C on 78 degrees.
- If you do not use your AC, please open windows to let in fresh air.
- Inspect for leaks under sinks.

If you have any work orders for items that you think can prevent mold, **please call your management office right away.**

Here are some examples of mold preventive work orders:

- Visible or suspected mold.
- Leaks, moisture accumulations, major spillage.
- Musty odors in the bathrooms.
- Leaking faucets, plumbing, pet urine accidents.
- Refrigerator and A/C drip pan overflows.
- Loose, missing grout or caulk throughout the unit.

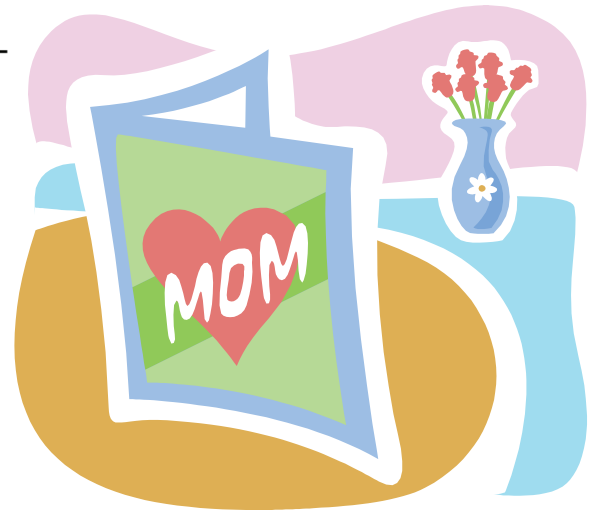
